INTRODUCTION

N.E.mation! is an annual digital animation competition organised by Nexus for youths to express their thoughts on Total Defence through 30 seconds animation clips.

In its 14th season, the competition continues to attract secondary and tertiary students who had the opportunity to produce broadcast-quality animation clips. Some of them did not have prior animation experience! With N.E.mation! 2020 receiving a total of 746 entries and more than 1,100 participants, it was a great season that showcased the students' great effort and understanding of Total Defence.

THEME - "TOGETHER WE KEEP SINGAPORE STRONG"

Singapore has remained safe and peaceful over the past 55 years because of the collective effort of all Singaporeans. This is Total Defence at work. Suggested Questions

- Do you think the white blood cells are similar to the six pillars of Total Defence? If yes, why?
- 2. What are some of the ways we can do our part to help Singapore's fight against COVID-19?
- 3. Why is it important for Singapore to stand strong and united at all times, especially during time times of crisis?

Suggested Activity

Write a short paragraph on how you feel about Singapore's fight against COVID-19 and what you would like to do to contribute and help Singapore stand strong and united. Share it with your parents / teacher thereafter.



SC02: Virus

Suggested Questions

- 2. What is phishing?
- 3. What are some things that you can do to check the credibility and accuracy of a suspicious website or email?

Suggested Activity

List out different online scam scenarios and their corresponding consequences. Share with your parents / teacher what you had found.



SC03: Packing a Punch

Different sheets of the tissue paper represents the different pillars of Total Defence and how they come together to make one united Singapore.

Suggested Questions

- 1. In the clip, what does the different layers of tissue in the tissue packet represent?
- Why is it important to be united and strong as a country?
- 3. What are some ways in which you can help keep Singapore strong?

Suggested Activity

Using the Total Defence 2020 Poster¹, match the 6 pillars of Total Defence to their representations in the illustration. Once you have done so, share it with your parents / teacher and discuss how you can practice the 6 pillars of Total Defence in your daily life.



SC04: Uninstall

Singapore is like a smart phone with Total Defence apps that keep us strong. What happens when any one of them gets deleted?

Suggested Questions

- 1. How do the six pillars of Total Defence help to keep Singapore strong?

- 3. Share how you put the six pillars of Total Defence in action in your daily life? Give examples.

Suggested Activity

Choose one or two pillars of Total Defence to remove, and discuss with your parents / teacher how this would affect you and Singapore as a whole.

Suggested Activity

Think of kind acts you have received from friends or family around you and show your appreciation towards them by writing them a card or giving them a call or text to say thank you.

Suggested Questions

- 1. How does upgrading one's skills relate to Total Defence?

Suggested Activity

Think about one skill that you would like to work on or upgrade. Develop a plan to improve on this skill and discuss with your parents / teacher.



SC07: Into the Cyberverse

Suggested Questions

- 1. In this clip, what do you think the purple monster represents?

- 3. Besides the example shown in the clip, identify other ways where you can work together to keep Singapore's defence strong.

Suggested Activity

Using 20 dry spaghetti sticks, 1 Marshmallow, some tape and some string, try and build a tower using the dry spaghetti sticks with the Marshmallow at the top. Ensure that the Marshmallow stays standing and the tower does not fall. Share with your parents / teacher how this represents Singapore and Total Defence.



SC08: Food Fight

Suggested Questions

Suggested Activity

Share a social media post about how you appreciate your friend from a different country / race today.

- 3. How does being adaptable to change lead to a stronger Singapore?

Suggested Activity

Draw a picture of some things that have changed around you lately due to COVID-19. Using that, explain how you and others around you have adapted to these changes and how it has contributed to a stronger Singapore.


With her new friends, Speedy, Stronghold and Digi, see how Sally overcomes the Virus in the Cyberverse.

Interview your parents or siblings and find out what defending our home means to them. Then share with them some of the ways you would like to help protect Singapore.

Suggested Questions

Suggested Activity

Compile a list of 2-3 recent examples of real and fake news in Singapore. Ask students to assess which are real or fake and allow them to share their reflections on the impact of fake news in Singapore.

- 3. What are some things we can do to help others in times of emergency?

Suggested Activity

Each student is to imagine they are Ali and act out how they would respond if they saw someone faint or need help.



YC05: Together, We Keep Singapore Flowing

Synopsis

The animation clip depicts how water has played a role in our nation's history.

Suggested Questions

- 1. Where does Singapore gets its water supply from?
- 2. Why is water important to Singapore?
- 3. What are some of the ways in which you could save water?

Suggested Activity

Using the Singapore map, point out the 17 reservoirs and 5 NEWater plants in Singapore and list them accordingly.



YC06: Reach

Suggested Questions

- 1. What is depression?
- 2. What can you do when you find that a friend or classmate is down and not doing well emotionally?
- 3. Sometimes the smallest acts can have the greatest impact. What are some things you can do in your everyday life to help those in your community?

Suggested Activity

Go online and find out some of the ways you can support someone through a sad or difficult time. Do up a social media post on ways we can stay positive and support ourselves and others through negative emotions.



YC07: Meh-licious

Synopsis

The dangers of radicalisation on the Internet become clear to a pair of friends.

Suggested Questions

- 1. How can radicalisation threaten our home and community?
- 2. Apart from radicalisation, what other dangers are there on the internet?
- 3. Do you think that terrorism is a serious threat in Singapore? Why or why not?

Suggested Activity

Find a news article on terrorism in Singapore. Once found, each student should share the news articles with their parents and explain how it makes them feel and what they would like to do to help protect Singapore.



YC08: Res-paw-nders

Synopsis

The community comes together when an otter needs help.

Suggested Questions

- 1. Do you agree with the way the two birds acted in the clip? Why or why not?
- 2. Why is it important for us to work together and be united?
- 3. In the clip it says, "Saving a life starts with you". In the midst of the Covid-19 pandemic, how do you think this applies to you?

Suggested Activity

Each student is to come up with three proverbs on helping one another, being prepared or doing good deeds. After writing the three proverbs on a piece of paper, the student should act it out for their parents to guess.
