
A hearing impaired deliveryman faces difficulties at work. He meets a little girl and through her actions of **unity and hope**, motivates him to **push through** and complete his tasks.














This short comedy reveals trivia about Singaporean food and touches on how our **unity and resilience** helped us through our problems.
