



Volunteers of **Project Hills, a groundup initiative** that offers various forms of support to families living in public rental housing estates.






Using digital technologies to address common social issues, student inventors **designed tech solutions to help people with disabilities gain more independence.**

Over 116,000 people signed up as SGSecure responders joining a pool of volunteers who spot suspicious activity and respond to emergencies including terror attacks.
